NOTE: Products should be mixed in with the amount of stock water that allows for bird consumption in six hours. Flush water lines before adding product to water.

### **Storage Information**

- For ideal long-term storage, product should be kept refrigerated.
- For short-term storage, product can be kept below 75 degrees.
